


ADVENTURES IN RANDOM ACTS OF KINDNESS

DIRECTIONS

- 1) Cut each strip of paper and arrange them in order by date.
- 2) Look and staple/tape each strip to create a paper chain.
- 3) Starting December 1, pull off a link in the chain and perform the act of kindness at some point during the day.
- 4) Use these acts to both bless others and as a way to remember the kindness that God the Father has shown by giving us his Son!

DEC 1 - Make a card for someone in the Military. (Bring to church on Sunday & we'll deliver it for you)

DEC 2 - Cut out snowflakes out of paper and decorate a window in your house.

DEC 3 - Leave change in a vending machine or gum ball dispenser

DEC 4 - Buy the coffee for the person behind you in line

DEC 5 - Say one thing you appreciate about everyone in your family

DEC 6 - Let someone in front of you in line today

DEC 7 - Smile at five people today

DEC 8 - Help a neighbor with their garbage, recycling or yard waste bins

DEC 9 - Volunteer at a food bank or donate food

DEC 10 - Deliver cookies/treats to library staff, fire station or police station

DEC 11 - Say thank you to your teacher/boss today

DEC 12 - Say something kind to someone at school/work today

DEC 13 - Bring a treat/flowers to your school lunch workers, nurse, custodian or office staff

DEC 14 - Hold the door open for someone you don't know

DEC 15 - Bring flowers to someone

DEC 16 - Pick up trash on your street

DEC 17 - Put change in a Salvation Army red bucket

DEC 18 - Do a siblings chore for them

DEC 19 - Write a letter to someone

DEC 20 - Clean up after yourself without having to be asked

DEC 21 - Learn about a Christmas tradition from another country

DEC 22 - Create a giant thank you card and give it to someone

DEC 23 - Bring a new magazine to a hospital waiting room

DEC 24 - Take a Christmas card to an all night drug store employee



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
